Entry fee £100 per team, £25 per individual

Class 5 100 Qualifier - Mixed Junior and Senior
First round 100cm; second round 105cm approx
Entry fee £100 per team, £25 per individual

Class 6 110 Qualifier - Mixed Junior and Senior
First round 110cm, second round 115cm approx
Entry Fee £100 per team, £25 per individual

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Prelim entries are to be made by the Team Organiser to the BRC Office on the official entry form or on-line, by Saturday 27 January 2018. **Cheques to BRC or on-line payment.**

Area team entries are to be made by the Team Organiser to Penny Briggs, Woolmer Lodge, Liss Forest, Liss, Hants GU33 7BU on the official Area Entry Form (available from BRC & Area 17 websites) by Thursday 8 February 2018, **payment to Meon Riding Club.**

Entry form must be accompanied by relevant passport pages (these must show horse name, passport number, silhouette and written description, plus full vaccination record).

Passport information can be sent by email **BUT ONLY IN PDF FORMAT** to woolmerlodge@yahoo.co.uk.

If sent by post Team organisers must initial and date the flu vaccination record as verification that they have checked it and it is correct. Where applicable, indicate with highlighter where last sequence starts. Please ensure each record is stapled together to prevent lost or mixed up pages.

Original passports must be brought on the day as random checking will be carried out.

HELPERS – each participating Club will be required to provide names and contact details of **1 helper (full day) or two helpers (half day) for each team** where team(s) is/are entered. The Relevant form will be sent to each participating Club and **must be returned with the area entry form.**

HATS – in accordance with 2018 rules, all hats must be tagged with current year tag,

Team Declarations – must be made at least 30 minutes before the start of class after which rider numbers will be issued. **but no changes may be made after this.**

Riders must report to Steward 15 minutes before their start time in each Class.

SUBSTITUTIONS: In the event of withdrawals, substitutions will be allowed. The deadline for complex substitutions will be midday Wednesday 14 February. Late simple substitutions, **which must be in writing**, may be made at the time teams are declared.

A complex substitution is one where teams are re-arranged or horse and rider combinations are moved from one team to another. Simple ones are where a horse and/or rider replace(s) the withdrawn one in the same team and position.

RULES

1. This competition will be run in accordance with the official rules for all British Riding Club Competitions 2018.
2. In order to qualify for the relevant British Riding Club Championships, entries must be made through clubs on the official forms.
3. It is the sole responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their horse has a valid flu vaccination record. Team organisers must send a copy of the record with the Area entry (see Entry Requirements).
4. Competitors only are allowed to ride the horse on the showground. Everyone mounted must wear a hard hat with the harness adjusted and fastened.

Area 17 Meon Riding Club and persons acting on their behalf, do not accept any liability for any loss, accident or damage to any person, animal, vehicle or goods occurring in connection with this event. It is a condition of entry that each competitor indemnifies the organiser against any claim.

HEALTH AND SAFETY: the organisers of this competition have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of officials and stewards.
