

BVRC General Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. All classes will be run in accordance with Official Rules for British Riding Clubs' Competitions 2012.
2. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that neither the organisers nor landowners nor their agents shall be held responsible for any loss, injury, damage to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants or horses or ponies, howsoever caused.
3. Everyone mounted, whether or not a competitor, shall wear correct riding clothes which must include Protective Headwear, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination.
'Protective Headwear' constitutes a hat meeting one of the following standards:

British	PAS 015:1998 or 2011, BSEN1384:1997	} Provided they are
European	EN1384:1996	} BSI Kitemarked or SEI
American	All SEI, ASTM F1163:2004, SNELL E2001	
Australian & New Zealand	All SAI AS/NZS 3838: 2003 or 2006	

Standards PAS015 and ASTM F1163 are considered to offer greater protection than EN1384 or BSEN1384. Skullcaps must be worn with an appropriate coloured silk.
Hair must be secured in a hair net or in such a way that it does not hang lower than the shoulder line.
Jewellery or any items worn in facial or body piercing are not permitted.
Chaps or half-chaps may not be worn.
Black or brown polished leather gaiters with matching boots are permitted.
Dressage Gloves are compulsory.
Show Jumping Body protectors are strongly recommended.
4. The organisers reserve the right in the light of prevailing circumstances to cancel the event, alter classes, judges, times or any other published information.
5. In all cases the Judge's decision is final. Any objection shall be accompanied by a deposit of £20 and within half an hour of the incident. The deposit will be returned only if the objection is upheld.
6. There will be no refund of entry fees.
7. For the avoidance of doubt claims for consequential liability, expenses or other payments shall in no circumstances be accepted.
8. **Dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times.**
9. Competitors must report to the relevant steward 10 minutes before their given start time for each phase. Failure to do so may incur elimination.
10. For the avoidance of doubt and unless explicitly stated to the contrary, medical facilities on the showground will be limited to standard NHS accident & emergency callout.
11. Any veterinary services utilised (including horse transportation, accommodation or legal disposal of deceased animals) shall be charged to and paid by the competitor. The BVRC does not guarantee that there will be immediate access to a horse ambulance on the showground. Unless otherwise stated, the BVRC does not guarantee that there will be immediate access to veterinary services on the showground.
12. Any farrier services utilised shall be charged to and paid for by the competitor. Unless otherwise stated, the BVRC does not guarantee that there will be immediate access to a farrier on the showground.
13. BVRC does not guarantee that the showground is a secure site. BVRC cannot guarantee that the showground perimeter cannot be breached by runaway animals. It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure, so far as is possible, that runaways cannot occur.
14. The BVRC's responsibility for runaway animals shall be limited to informing the local civil or military police. All costs incurred in any recovery including the cost of any damage incurred during the incident shall be charged to and paid by the competitor.

Health & Safety Policy The organiser of this event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health & safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and shall obey the instructions of the organiser, and all officials & stewards.

Please remember that event organisers and their teams are volunteers who give up their time for your benefit.

Two team members are to compete in the Novice section and two in the Intermediate section.

Qualification for horses and riders is specified in Official Rules for British Riding Clubs' Competitions 2012.

Junior & Senior Novice Section

DRESSAGE BD Prelim 14 (2006)
SHOW JUMPING 75cm Speed: 325 metres per minute.

Junior & Senior Intermediate Section

DRESSAGE BD Novice 27 (2007)
SHOW JUMPING 85cm Speed: 325 metres per minute.

Competition Notes: For the avoidance of doubt, competitors shall understand that the rules and conditions of entry (listed below) are the sole terms under which the Bourne Valley Riding Club (BVRC) organises competitions. Competitors shall not enter BVRC events unless they have read, understood and fully accepted these terms.

Entries

Preliminary entries are to be received by BRC Office by Friday 20th April 2012, 3pm.

*Detailed entries on BRC Official entry form are to be sent to **Lindsay Hills, The Ridings, Dauntsey Lane, Weyhill, Nr Andover, Hants SP11 8EB.** by Thursday 3rd May. Please include an SAE if you wish times to be posted.*

Entry Fees: £100 per team (Cheques payable to Bourne Valley Riding Club)

Flu Vaccinations

Photocopies of Flu Vaccination certificate/Passports must be submitted with the entry form. Please ensure the copy has every section (front, back & middle) of the certificate – including the name & address of the owner, the horse's name, silhouette, markings & every single vaccinations entry.

Flu Vaccination Certificate/Passport must be presented on the day, on collection of numbers. Spot checks will be done.

Helpers:

*Each participating **TEAM** will be required to supply a helper (11.45am-5pm). Names and contact details are to be submitted with entries.*

Start times:

Times will be available on www.bvrc.co.uk from 6pm on Wednesday 9th May or posted if an SAE is supplied.

Substitutions:

Any team changes will be accepted up to 8pm on Thursday 10th May. Individual team replacements will be accepted up to ½ hour before the start of the class, provided there is a valid reason.

Declarations:

Declarations must be made at least ½ hour before the start of class.

Hat Tagging:

All hats must be tagged before competitors will be allowed to ride.

ALL HATS MUST BE PRESENTED FOR CHECKING EVEN IF THEY HAVE ALREADY BEEN TAGGED.
