We regret that there can be no refund or transfers of entry fees after close of entries unless a veterinary or medical certificate is produced within 7 days of the event or the space filled from any wait list. HEALTH AND SAFETY The organisers and land owners have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. INSURANCE All Riding Club Members are covered by third party insurance when attending a Riding Club Event. Hats must be worn whenever mounted or handling a horse and conform to current BRC Rules – Harnesses must be correctly adjusted and fastened. No head cams allowed. Correct dress and footwear with defined heels must be worn. All horses and ponies must be 4 yrs old and over. Entries accepted at rider's risk. VEC reserve the right to refuse an entry at their discretion, cancel, amend or amalgamate any class for any reason whatsoever. The organiser's decision is final. Working in will be on grass. Tests ridden on a surface. Please respect the facilities and do not bring any hay nets to the outside of your lorry/trailer or leave any horse tied up and unattended. Please also make sure that you clear any droppings, hay debris, etc. from around your vehicle.
